Miami Cancer Institute takes a multidisciplinary approach to care. This means that you will have a team of experts from across many disciplines focused on the best treatment plan for you.

We've built Miami Cancer Institute with a team of cancer experts, many trained at leading academic institutions, who understand your cancer and your individual needs. Their expertise, combined with the recommendations of multidisciplinary tumor boards, advanced cancer-fighting technology and innovative clinical trials (some in collaboration with our alliance partner, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center), ensures all patients at Miami Cancer Institute get a personalized plan of therapy that is the best possible treatment for their cancer.

Advanced Treatments

At Miami Cancer Institute, our physicians and teams offer the most-advanced treatments for common, rare and complex cancers. Treatments include:

- Autologous and allogeneic stem cell transplantation, the latter using T-cell depleted products to reduce complications.
- CAR T-cell therapy for lymphoma (with plans to expand use to other cancer types).
- Microvascular reconstruction for patients undergoing surgery for breast cancer, head and neck cancers and for sarcoma.
- Minimally invasive and robotic techniques for hepatobiliary, gastrointestinal, gynecologic, thoracic and urologic surgery.
- Nonsurgical interventional oncology procedures to treat liver metastases and benign and malignant pancreatic lesions.
- Nonsurgical interventional gastroenterology procedures to treat benign and malignant bile duct and pancreatic lesions.
- Prostatic artery embolization, a nonsurgical technique to treat benign prostatic hypertrophy.
- All forms of advanced radiation therapy (see below).
- Transoral (through the lower lip, avoiding a neck scar) surgery to treat thyroid cancer.
- Surgical and non-surgical treatments for localized prostate cancer, including high-intensity focused ultrasound.

- A full range of patient and family support services in our unique Cancer Patient Support Center, including psychosomatic medicine psychiatrists, psychologists, cancer rehabilitation physicians, nutritionists and acupuncturists.
- A team of board certified specialists in palliative care dedicated to cancer-specific symptom management and palliative care.

The Latest Technology

Miami Cancer Institute is focused on bringing the latest tools to the fight against cancer. We are often among the first in the country to offer new technologies to our patients. At Miami Cancer Institute, we offer:

- Three-room, pencil-beam scanning proton therapy, the latest and most precise radiation therapy delivery system.
- CyberKnife robotic, image-guided radiation system for radiation delivery almost anywhere in the body.
- Magnetic resonance linear accelerator (MR Linac) for more accurate delivery of radiation for certain tumor locations.
- Positron emission tomography/magnetic resonance (PET/MR) for highly detailed images, aiding the precise delivery of radiation therapy.
- Vectra 3D imaging for skin cancer.
